LEAVE WILD ANIMALS IN THE WILD

Exotic pets are in fashion. Monkeys, crocodiles, rare snakes like anacondas and even lions are all examples of exotic creatures that pet owners are bringing home.

These animals are often status symbols, and people purchase them just to impress their friends and neighbors.



What these pet owners don't realize, however, is that their cuddly little pets increase in size and need a lot more food and space as they grow. Moreover, since they are wild animals, they often become aggressive and unmanageable. "Kiara seemed so cute when we first got her," says Arnold Smith of Buffalo, New York about his pet lion. "But she's turned into a monster!" Today, Kiara is locked in a small cage in Smith's backyard. Looking back, Smith admits that he made a huge mistake. "I should never have gotten her," he says with regret in his voice.

While Smith is still not sure what to do next with his pet lion, others in a similar situation, try to get rid of their pet as fast as possible. Some are given to animal shelters and others to zoos. But at least these animals find a new home, which can't be said for the majority of exotic pets that are abandoned by their owners. "Animals are let loose in forests or open spaces near towns and cities," says forest ranger Sam Johnson who has come across a wide range of exotic animals, including monkeys and anacondas. "Ownership of exotic pets should be banned," he says. "It is very cruel to the poor creatures and not safe for the rest of us."

Owning an exotic animal might be considered a fashion statement, but it is actually a statement of cruelty and lack of responsibility. Only strict laws can stop this practice and make the lives of people and wild animals a lot safer and happier.
